TRANSFER THE STONE

Richly rewarded shall he be who succeeds in finding it and richly rewarded will be the Lodge that holds the Provincial Travelling Keystone.

When holding the Provincial Travelling Keystone your Lodge is responsible for its safe keeping and for ensuring its successful transfer - a great opportunity for brethren to visit other Lodges in the Province, make new friendships or enhance existing ones. Can't wait for your Lodge to receive the Provincial Travelling Keystone...

CLAIM THE STONE

If your Lodge doesn't currently retain the Keystone, why not put together a raiding party and claim it from the current holders... they will be pleased to see you !

Don't leave it too late to organise a raiding party though, someone may beat you to it.

HOW TO JOIN IN

Contact the Provincial Travelling Keystone Organiser for full details, terms and conditions; his details and contact information can be obtained from the Provincial Grand Secretary or by asking any member of the Provincial Executive.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Before accepting or claiming the Provincial Travelling Keystone, your Lodge will need to agree to certain terms of engagement - these include making brethren available to accompany the Keystone, when being transferred, or arranging a raiding party to claim the stone; equally, you may have to host a delegation from another Lodge, should they attempt to claim the Keystone or transfer it to you. Full details of the terms of engagement may be obtained from the Provincial Grand Secretary.

WHO HAS HELD THE KEYSTONE

Every Lodge receiving or claiming the Travelling Keystone is expected to complete a scroll, containing details of all those brethren who joined in the journey, which is then deposited and stored within the Keystone - why not add your Lodge's name and become part of Provincial history.
